2 Peter 1:19-21 And so we have the prophetic word confirmed,\* which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts; <sup>20</sup> knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation,\* <sup>21</sup> for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God\* spoke *as they were* moved by the Holy Spirit.

2 Timothy 4:9-11 Be diligent to come to me quickly; <sup>10</sup> for Demas has forsaken me, having loved this present world, and has departed for Thessalonica — Crescens for Galatia, Titus for Dalmatia. <sup>1</sup>

Jude 11 Woe to them! For they have gone in the way of Cain, have run greedily in the error of Balaam for profit, and perished in the rebellion of Korah.

**Psalm 139:13-16** For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb. <sup>14</sup> I will praise You, for I am fearfully *and* wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and *that* my soul knows very well. <sup>15</sup> My frame was not hidden from You, when I was made in secret, *and* skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. <sup>16</sup> Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, the days fashioned for me, when *as yet there were* none of them.

**Isaiah 46:9-11** Remember the former things of old, for I *am* God, and *there is* no other; *I am* God, and *there is* none like Me, <sup>10</sup> Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times *things* that are not *yet* done, Saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure, <sup>11</sup> Calling a bird of prey from the east, the man who executes My counsel, from a far country. Galatians 3:26-29 For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. <sup>27</sup> For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. <sup>28</sup> There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. <sup>29</sup> And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

John 1:12-13 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: <sup>13</sup> who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

#### Luke 6:43-45

<sup>43</sup> "For a good tree does not bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. <sup>44</sup> For every tree is known by its own fruit. For *men* do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush.

### John 15:1-8

### Numbers 25:1-9 NKJV

- 25 Now Israel remained in Acacia Grove,\* and the people began to commit harlotry with the women of Moab. <sup>2</sup> They invited the people to the sacrifices of their gods, and the people ate and bowed down to their gods. <sup>3</sup> So Israel was joined to Baal of Peor, and the anger of the LORD was aroused against Israel.

### Numbers 31:1-19

- **31** And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: <sup>2</sup> "Take vengeance on the Midianites for the children of Israel. Afterward you shall be gathered to your people." <sup>3</sup> So Moses spoke to the people, saying, "Arm some of yourselves for war, and let them go against the Midianites to take vengeance for the LORD on Midian. <sup>4</sup> A thousand from each tribe of all the tribes of Israel you shall send to the war."
- <sup>5</sup> So there were recruited from the divisions of Israel one thousand from *each* tribe, twelve thousand armed for war. <sup>6</sup> Then Moses sent them to the war, one thousand from *each* tribe; he sent them to the war with Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, with the holy articles and the signal trumpets in his hand. <sup>7</sup> And they warred against the Midianites, just as the LORD commanded Moses, and they killed all the males. <sup>8</sup> They killed the kings of Midian with *the rest of* those who were killed Evi, Rekem, Zur, Hur, and Reba, the five kings of Midian. Balaam the son of Beor they also killed with the sword. <sup>9</sup> And the children of Israel took the women of Midian captive, with their little ones, and took as spoil all their cattle, all their flocks, and all their goods. <sup>10</sup> They also burned with fire all the cities where they dwelt, and all their forts. <sup>11</sup> And they took all the spoil and all the booty of man and beast.
- <sup>12</sup> Then they brought the captives, the booty, and the spoil to Moses, to Eleazar the priest, and to the congregation of the children of Israel, to the camp in the plains of Moab by the Jordan, *across from* Jericho. <sup>13</sup> And Moses, Eleazar the priest, and all the leaders of the congregation, went to meet them outside the camp. <sup>14</sup> But Moses was angry with the officers of the army, *with* the captains over thousands and captains over hundreds, who had come from the battle.
- <sup>15</sup> And Moses said to them: "Have you kept all the women alive? <sup>16</sup> Look, these *women* caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to trespass against the LORD in the incident of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD. <sup>17</sup> Now therefore, kill every male among the little ones, and kill every woman who has known a man intimately. <sup>18</sup> But keep alive for yourselves all the young girls who have not known a man intimately.

- § Targum of Onkelos: "...desisted from praying in the name..."
- § Targum of Jonathan: "Surnamed their idols in the name..."
- § Kimchi, Rashi, & other ancient Jewish commentators agree Jerome indicated this opinion of many Jews of his day.
- § Maimonides, *Commentary on the Mishna* (a constituent part of the Talmud), AD 1168, ascribes the origin of idolatry to the days of Enos.

#### Four Hebrew words for "Man":

- § Adam "origin" the "dust of the adamah" (ground)
- § Ish "sex" a male
- § Geber "strength" a mighty man
- § Enosh "infirmities" a physically mortal character, incurable (over 500X)

## Enos = frail, weak, sickly, incurable:

- **§** When during Enosh's life did his mortality become apparent?
- § This incurable state of mankind might have given rise to the prophet Enoch, who appeared on the scene 400 years after Enosh was born
- § Possible pattern?
  - Third from Adam: Enosh, who began to profane the name of the Lord
  - Jonathan, grandson of Moses, first idolatrous priest in Israel (Judges 18:30).

Hebrews 5:5 KJV So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee. 6 As he saith also in another place, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. 7 Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared; 8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; 9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him; 10 Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec.

Hebrews 12:1-2 KJV Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, 2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

1 Timothy 1:1-2 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ, by the commandment of God our Savior and the Lord Jesus Christ, our hope, 2 To Timothy, a true son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 Timothy 2:3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior,

Titus 3:4-7 But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, 5 not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, 6 whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

Psalms 106:19-21 19 They made a calf in Horeb, and worshiped the molded image. 20 Thus they changed their glory into the image of an ox that eats grass. 21 They forgot God their Savior, Who had done great things in Egypt,

Isaiah 60:16 You shall drink the milk of the Gentiles, and milk the breast of kings; you shall know that I, the Lord, am your Savior and your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob.

Luke 2:9 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid.

Acts 22:9-11 "And those who were with me indeed saw the light and were afraid, but they did not hear the voice of Him who spoke to me. 10 So I said, 'What shall I do, Lord?' And the Lord said to me, 'Arise and go into Damascus, and there you will be told all things which are appointed for you to do.' 11 And since I could not see for the glory of that light, being led by the hand of those who were with me, I came into Damascus.

Revelation 15:8 The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.

Hebrews 1:2-3 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; 3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Revelation 19:6 And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!

2 Corinthians 6:18 'I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."

Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spoke unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Romans 13:1-2 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. 2 Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves.

1 Chronicles 29:10-13 Therefore David blessed the Lord before all the assembly; and David said: "Blessed are You, Lord God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever. 11 Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all. 12 Both riches and honor come from You, and You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all. 13 "Now therefore, our God, we thank You and praise Your glorious name.

Revelation 4:8-11 The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!" Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: 11 "You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created."
